GUMC MISSION GOALS FOR 2025

Our Goal for 2025 is to continue to pursue our benevolent giving goal of *AT LEAST 10%* of our church budget. We will continue to encourage **your participation** in missions and outreach through our Faith Promise Giving, with any commitment shortfall being met through our General Fund.
